Registration of participants:	Preliminary applications and registration forms are accepted from national federations and clubs. These forms are sent to the Chief Secretary at samartsev@fsmr.ru, and their copies are forwarded to FSMR Regional Department in Vladivostok at holosha@msun.ru. Team leaders should submit the original registration forms to the document commission during the registration procedure on 15 August 2023. Any citizen of any country may participate in the competition having sent the application (within the permitted number of participants).

Flags and national anthems:	Each national team should provide 3 national flags, 150x100 cm, and a USB stick with their national anthem recorded on it. Team leaders will receive their flags and USB sticks after the closing and awards ceremony of the Championship.
Medals and certificates:	Participants who win the first three places in each sports discipline will be awarded with medals and diplomas. Juniors (young men and women up to 19 years old) who achieve three best results in their corresponding age group will be additionally awarded with special prizes. All participants will receive Certificates of Participation in the “Eurasia Championship-2024”.
